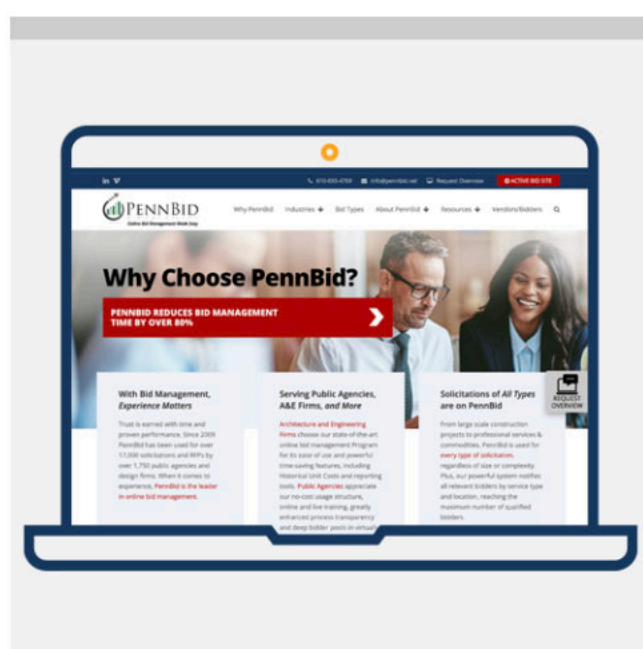

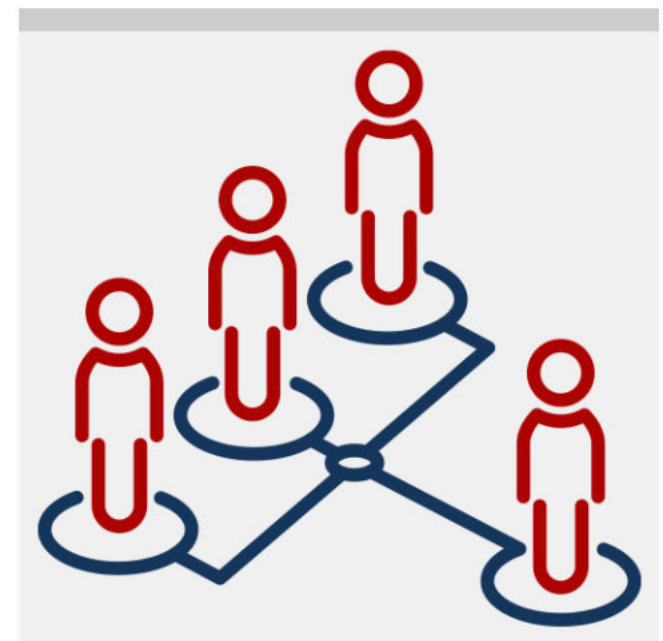
## Tiered User Groups and Permission Roles

Larger organizations sometimes desire to separate access by departments or geographies, while managers / leaders maintain oversight of all groups or departments. For example, counties often want to keep bids and related User access within specific departments, or a design firm with a larger geographic footprint may wish to separate them by offices or disciplines, but still have leadership access to all.

PennBid's Tiered Access capability allows for these possibilities. In addition, with a wide variety of User Permissions, roles and capabilities can be highly customized. As an example, the county "Controller" role limits the ability to unseal bids to individuals who have the authority to do so.

## Historical Unit Cost Feature

Did you know that PennBid's Historical Unit Cost feature allows Users to search hundreds of thousands of real-world bid prices as current as yesterday? This is an extremely powerful tool for budgeting, estimating, or comparing prices - especially in today's bidding environment.

When enabled, the extensive database can be queried to access unit costs, pricing differentials, and full descriptions, including unit quantity from all projects and solicitations in the system. Further, results can be exported, sorted, and filtered by geography and timeframe.
