

One-Bid & No-Bid Scenarios - Know Your Options


At times, your solicitation may receive less sealed bids than desired/necessary. With PennBid, this does not have to mean re-bidding. Options are available; however, there are a couple of key factors that must be known BEFORE the solicitation is unsealed.

Multi-Prime Projects

Did you know that you can easily create a multi-prime project in PennBid so that all contracts (such as General Construction, Electrical, Plumbing, HVAC, etc.) are managed within one solicitation?

While the basic framework is similar to a single-prime project, there are some nuances and features to consider with multi-primes. When coupled with the "Grouping" feature, this allows you to sort your bid tabulations by contract individually, in addition to as a whole.
